Die Bildung des Passive mit 'by' (by-Agent)**Aktiv**

Tom writes a letter.

The classes use computers.

Passiv

The letter **is written by** Tom.

Computers **are used by** the classes.

Setze den By-Agent in die Lücken der Passive Sätze ein.

The teacher opens the door. (Aktive)

The door is opened **by the teacher**. (Passive)

Mrs Tompson builds a house. (Aktive)

A house is build **by Mrs Tompson**. (Passive)

The dog bites Amy. (Aktive)

Amy is bitten **by the dog**. (Passive Voice)

John cooks a meal. (Aktive)

A meal is cooked **by John**. (Passive Voice)

The rats sing a song. (Aktive)

A song is sung **by the rats**. (Passive Voice)

The mechanic repairs the car. (Aktive)

The car is repaired **by the mechanic**. (Passive Voice)

Tourists visit London every year. (Aktive)

Every year London is visited **by tourists**. (Passive Voice)

The child eats cakes. (Aktive)

Cakes are eaten **by the child**. (Passive Voice)
