was/were + Past Participle (3. Form)

Setze das Passive im Simple Past ein.

He **was given** a book. (to give)

These films **were made** in England. (to make)

The doors **were opened** by the teacher. (to open)

She **was taken** to hospital. (to take)

The movie **was watched** by millions of people. (to watch)

Setze das Passive im Simple Past ein.

Somebody stole my mobile. (Satz im Aktiv, Simple Past)

My mobile **was stolen**. (Satz im Passiv, Simple Past)

They built the hospital. (Satz im Aktiv, Simple Past)

The **hospital was built**. (Satz im Passiv, Simple Past)

He bought the inline-skates. (Satz im Aktiv, Simple Past)

The **inline-skates were bought**. (Satz im Passiv, Simple Past)

He corrected the tests. (Satz im Aktiv, Simple Past)

The **tests were corrected**. (Satz im Passiv, Simple Past)

They sold magazines. (Satz im Aktiv, Simple Past)

Magazines were sold. (Satz im Passiv, Simple Past)
