have/has + Subjekt + Past Participle

<p>Have I listened to the song? Have you listened to the song? Has he/she listened to the song? Have we listened to the song? Have you listened to the song? Have they listened to the song?</p>
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Bilde Fragen im Present Perfect.

1. I have listened to the new teacher. (Present Perfect Aussagesatz)

Have I listened to the new teacher? (Fragesatz)

2. You have listened to the new teacher. (Present Perfect Aussagesatz)

Have you listened to the new teacher? (Fragesatz)

3. He/She has listened to the new teacher. (Present Perfect Aussagesatz)

Has he/she listened to the new teacher? (Fragesatz)

4. We have listened to the new teacher. (Present Perfect Aussagesatz)

Have we listened to the new teacher? (Fragesatz)

5. You have listened to the new teacher. (Present Perfect Aussagesatz)

Have you listened to the new teacher? (Fragesatz)

6. They have listened to the new teacher. (Present Perfect Aussagesatz)

7. **Have they listened** to the new teacher? (Fragesatz)

The cat has chased the bird. (Present Perfect Aussagesatz)

8. **Has the cat chased** the bird? (Fragesatz)

We have lifted the box. (Present Perfect Aussagesatz)

9. **Have we lifted** the box? (Fragesatz)

Jane and Ben have packed the suitcases. (Present Perfect Aussagesatz)

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10. **Have** *Jane and Ben* **packed** the suitcases? (Fragesatz)

I have waved goodbye. (Present Perfect Aussagesatz)

11. **Have** / **waved** goodbye? (Fragesatz)
