Die Bildung des Simple Past - regelmäßige Verben – Arbeitsblatt Lösungen

Bei den regelmäßigen Verben hängt man im Simple Past **-ed** an den Infinitiv (Grundform) an.

Beispiele: cook - cook**ed**, play - play**ed**, wash - wash**ed**,

Steht am Ende des Verbs schon ein unbetontes **e**, dann wird nur **-d** angehängt.

Beispiele: love - love**d**, live - live**d**, close - close**d**, live - live**d**
