Die Bildung des Passiv mit dem 'by' (by-Agent)	
Aktiv	Passiv
Tom writes a letter.	The letter is written by Tom.
The classes use computers.	Computers are used by the classes.

1. Setze den By-Agent in die Lücken der Passiv-Sätze ein.

The teacher opens the door. (Active)

The door is opened **by the teacher**. (Passive Voice)

Mrs Tompson builds a house. (Active)

A house is build **by Mrs Tompson**. (Passive Voice)

The dog bites Amy. (Active)

Amy is bitten **by the dog**. (Passive Voice)

John cooks a meal. (Active)

A meal is cooked **by John**. (Passive Voice)

The rats sing a song. (Active)

A song is sung **by the rats**. (Passive Voice)

The mechanic repairs the car. (Active)

The car is repaired **by the mechanic**. (Passive Voice)

Tourists visit London every year. (Active)

Every year London is visited **by tourists**. (Passive Voice)

The child eats cakes. (Active)

Cakes are eaten **by the child**. (Passive Voice)
