(Passive Voice, Past Perfect) He had cleaned the room. (Aktive, Past Perfect) The room had been cleaned. (Passive Voice, Past Perfect) They had informed mother. (Aktive, Past Perfect) Mother had been informed. (Passive Voice, Past Perfect) They had moved the table. (Aktive, Past Perfect) They had moved the table. (Aktive, Past Perfect) The table had been moved. (Passive Voice, Past Perfect)
