Aussagesatz: had + Past Participle (3. Form)

Verneinung: had + n't + Past Participle (3. Form)

An animal all the roses. (to eat)

An animal had eaten all the roses.

The girl a shower. (to have)

The girl had had a shower.

Jane tennis. (not to play)

Jane hadn't played tennis.

Peter Sue to the party. (not to invite)

Peter hadn't invited Sue to the party.

They their dinner. (not to finish)

They hadn't finished their dinner.

She in London. (to be)

She had been in London.

The children to bed. (to go)

The children had gone to bed.

We to the headmaster. (not to talk)

We hadn't talked to the headmaster.

They on that problem. (not to work)

They hadn't worked on that problem.

Someone my bike. (to steal)

Someone had stolen my bike.

An animal all the roses. (not to eat)

An animal hadn't eaten all the roses.

The girl a shower. (not to have)

The girl hadn't had a shower.
