Für die Verneinung im Simple Present verwende '**do**' und '**does**' sowie die Verneinung '**not**'. Die Kurzformen lauten: *don't* und *doesn't*. Danach folgt der **Infinitiv**.

Beispiele für die Verneinung in Simple Present

I don't go to school. (Ich gehe nicht zur Schu-
le.)
You don't go to school.
He/Se doesn't go to school.
We don't go to school.
You don't go to school.
They don't go to school.

1. Wähle don't oder doesn't aus und danach das Verb.

I work at home. I **don't** work at home. You work at home. You **don't** work at home. He/She works at home. He/She **doesn't** work at home. We work at home. We **don't** work at home. You work at home. You **don't** work at home. They work at home. They **don't** work at home.

2. Wähle don't oder doesn't aus und danach das Verb.

You work very hard. You *don't* work very hard. Jack plays the guitar. Jack *doesn't* play the guitar. They go to the club. They *don't* go to the club. Jake and Sue like rock music. Jake and Sue *don't* like rock music. She goes to the cinema. She *doesn't* go to the cinema. They play computer games. They *don't* play computer games. She lives in London. She *doesn't* live in London. We eat lunch at the restaurant. We *don't* eat lunch at the restaurant. My mother understands Spanish. My mother *doesn't* understand Spanish. Jake and Emma like Chinese takeaways. Jake and Emma *don't* like Chinese takeaways.
