Vergleich: Simple Present / Present Progressive

Simple present Signalwörter – signal words

Simple Present **Signalwörter**: always, every, never, normally, now and then, occasionally, often, rarely, seldom, sometimes, usually.

Present progressive - Signalwörter - signal words

Present Progressive **Signalwörter**: at the moment, at present, just, just now, now, right now, still, today, tonight.

Look! Listen!

1. Setze das Simple Present ein oder das Present Progressive.

Ben *often reads* the newspaper. (Beispiel für das Simple Present)

Beispiel: It *is raining* right now. (Beispiel für das Present Progressive)

Ben often **reads** the newspapers. (to read)

Listen! Somebody **is calling** you. (to call)

He **is** always late. (to be - am, is, are)

He **visits** Andy every Friday. (to visit)

I never **drink** coffee in the morning. (to drink)

It **is raining** at present. (to rain)

The train **is arriving** at the moment. (to arrive)

They always **work** early. (to work)

Jane **is playing** the guitar now. (to play)

2. Simple Present oder Present Progressive?

Peter often **loses** his bike key. (to lose)

The birds **are singing** today (to sing)

He **comes** to my house every Friday. (to come)

The girls **are playing** football at the moment. (to play)

We never **sleep** before 9 o'clock. (to sleep)

Ben often **reads** the newspapers. (to read)

She **is eating** her lunch just now. (to eat)

We **are playing** the guitar now. (to play)

I **eat** an orange every day. (to eat)
