**1. Setze das Simple Present ein oder das Present Progressive.**

Peter often **loses** his bike key. (to lose)

The birds **are singing** today (to sing)

He **comes** to my house every Friday. (to come)

The girls **are playing** football at the moment. (to play)

We never **sleep** before 9 o'clock. (to sleep)

Ben often **reads** the newspapers. (to read)

She **is eating** her lunch just now. (to eat)

We **are playing** the guitar now. (to play)

I **eat** an orange every day. (to eat)

**2. Simple Present oder Present Progressive?**

The train **is arriving** at the moment. (to arrive)

Jake and Ben usually **get** up at 6 o'clock. (to get)

Look over there! The cats **are running** after the mouse. (to run)

He **eats** toast every day. (to eat)

I always **do** my homework. (to do)

Sarah **is wearing** jeans today. (to wear)

He often **spends** an hour in the bathroom. (to spend)

I always **eat** chocolate. (to eat)

The train **is coming** into the station right now. (to come)
