1. Simple Past oder Past Perfect?

1. After the group *had visited* London, they *flew* to Edinburgh. (to visit/to fly)
2. Before the students *started* the test they *had switched* off their mobiles. (to start/to switch)
3. After we **had phoned** Mum we **went** to the hospital. (to phone/to go)
4. Jake **arrived** at the bus stop after the bus **had left**. (to arrive/to leave)
5. After the guests **had gone**, the kids **cleaned** the house. (to go/to clean)
6. When the friends **got** to the cinema, the film **had started**. (to get/to start)
7. He **gave** me the DVD back after he **had watched** it. (to give/to watch)
8. Jake **answered** the email two minutes after he **had received** it. (to answer/to receive)
9. After we **had been** to the concert we **ate** at a snack bar. (to be/to eat)
10. After we **had eaten**, we **returned** home. (to eat/to return)

2. Simple Past or Past Perfect?

1. When Sue **had finished** her homework she **emailed** it to her teacher. (to finish/to email)
2. After she **had sent** the email she **switched** on the TV. (to send/to switch)
3. After she **had watched** her favourite soap, she **called** her friend. (to watch/to call)
4. Emma's friend **came** round after he **had played** football. (to come/to play)
5. We **went** for a walk when it **had stopped** snowing. (to go/to stop)
6. Before she **fed** the dog, she **had taken** him for a walk. (to feed/to take)
7. She **told** the teacher her name after he **had asked** her a few times. (to tell/to ask)
8. After Mum had **made** a pizza, she **baked** a cake. (to make/to bake)
9. We **had bought** the tickets before we **went** to the concert. (to buy/to go)
10. I **read** my emails after I **had finished** my homework. (to read/to finish)
