Merke: If-Satz Typ I



If-Satz: Der If-Satz steht im Simple Present.

Hauptsatz: Im Hauptsatz stehen will + Infinitiv.

Der If-Satz Typ I bedeutet: Etwas ist *wahrscheinlich*.

If-Satz Typ I	If the game <b>is</b> good,	<b>I will play</b> it.
If-Satz Typ I	<b>I will play</b> the game	<b>if</b> it <b>is</b> good.
