LÖSUNG

Merke: If-Satz Typ I

If-Satz: Der If-Satz steht im Simple Present.

Hauptsatz: Im Hauptsatz stehen will + Infinitiv.

Der If-Satz Typ I bedeutet: Etwas ist *wahrscheinlich*.

If-Satz Typ I	If the game <b>is</b> good,	I <b>will play</b> it.
If-Satz Typ I	I <b>will play</b> the game	<b>if</b> it <b>is</b> good.

1. If-Sätze Typ I: Setze das Verb richtig ein.

1. If Ben goes to the cinema, he **will see** his friends. (see)
2. If the classroom door is open, the pupils **will go** in. (go)
3. If air **gets** warmer, it will rise. (get)
4. She will come to your party if you **invite** her. (invite)
5. She **will give** you the ticket if you give her the money. (give)

2. If-Sätze Typ I: Setze das Verb richtig ein.

1. If you **are** cold, I will make you a cup of tea. (be)
2. My dad **will repair** my bike if it is broken. (repair)
3. If you **forget** the map, we will lose our way. (forget)
4. If you turn on the radio, we **will hear** the news. (hear)
5. If the temperature **falls** below zero, it will freeze. (fall)

3. If-Sätze Typ I: Setze das Verb richtig ein.

1. Ben **will go** shopping if mum **feels** ill. (go/feel)
2. Ben **will carry** the bag if you **ask** him. (carry/ask)
3. **Will** you **put** the cups on the table if I **pass** them to you? (put/pass)
4. He **will show** you the photos if he **fetches** them from the shop. (show/fetch)
5. They **will watch** the TV if the guests **don't come** too early. (watch/**not** come)
