If-Satz = Simple Present.

Hauptsatz = will + Infinitiv.



If-Satz Typ I Aussage	I will play the game,	if it is good.
If-Satz Typ I Verneinung	I will watch the film,	If you don't come.
If-Satz Typ I Frage	Will I work at home,	if you come ?

1. If-Satz Typ I – Aussagesatz, Frage: Setze die Verben richtig ein.

1. Somebody **will come** if you **ring** the bell. (come/ring)
2. They **will be** ill if they **drink** that water. (be/drink)
3. If a beggar **asks** you for money, **will** you **give** him any? (ask/give)
4. I **will come** if I **have** nothing to do. (come/have)
5. He **will arrive** by midday if he **starts** at once. (arrive/start)

2. If-Satz Typ I - Frage, Verneinung, Aussagesatz

1. You **will catch** the train if you **leave** earlier. (catch/leave)
2. If it **is** fine, I **will go** for a swim. (be/go)
3. What **will** you **do** if you **meet** Jake? (do/meet)
4. If you **do** your homework, the teacher **will be** happy. (do/be)
5. If the reporter **takes** photos, she **will ask** him for them. (take/ask)
6. The girl **will take** an umbrella if it **rains**. (take/rain)
