Conditional sentences / If clauses, type II

LÖSUNG

Der If-Satz Typ II bedeutet: Etwas ist *unwahrscheinlich*.



If-Satz Typ II	If- Satz Simple Past	would + Infinitv
Beispiel:	If I lived in Australia,	I would be a sheep farmer.

If-Sätze Typ 2: Setze die Verben im Hauptsatz und im If-Satz richtig ein.

1. If he **started** at once, he **would arrive** there by midday. (start/arrive)
2. Tom **would be** sick if he **ate** all those chocolates. (be/eat)
3. If I **lost** my glasses, I **wouldn't be able** to read. (lose/not be)
4. You **would become** ill if you **forgot** your jacket. (become/forget)
5. If the weather **got** colder, I **would buy** a new coat. (get/buy)

Bilde If-Sätze Typ 2.

1. if – it – snow/ I – go – skiing
If **it snowed**, I **would go skiing**.
2. If I – earn – some money/I – buy – some books
If I **earned some money**, I **would buy some books**.
3. he – feel – better /if he – do - some sport
He **would feel better** if **he did some sport**.
4. we – not have – any pocket money /if we – not work – at the weekends
We **wouldn't have any pocket money** if we **didn't work at the weekends**.
5. Jake – be – angry/if I – not visit – him
Jake **would be angry** if I **didn't visit him**.
