**Conditional sentences / If clauses, type III****LÖSUNG**Der If-Satz Typ III bedeutet: Etwas war *völlig unmöglich*.**If-Satz Typ III****If- Satz Past Perfect****would + have + Past Participle**

Beispiel:

If I **had had** nothing to do,I **would have come**.**1. If-Sätze Typ III: Setze die fehlenden Verben in der richtigen Form ein.**

1. If you had taken a taxi, you **would have caught** the train. (take)
2. I **would have come** if I had had nothing to do. (have)
3. The pupils would have missed the bus if they **hadn't left** early. (miss)
4. If the friends had gone to the cafe, they **would have eaten** pizzas. (go)
5. If I had had enough money, I **would have bought** that mobile. (have)

**2. If-Sätze Typ III: Setze die Verben in der richtigen Form ein.**

1. I would have written to him if he **had written** to me. (write)
2. If Dad **had been** a pilot, he would have taken me with him. (take)
3. My uncle **would have been** able to help us if he had been here. (be)
4. She wouldn't have known the answer if she **hadn't read** the text message. (**not** know) (Kurzform der Verneinung)
5. The man would never have found the house if he **had not asked** a policeman. (**not** ask) (lange Form der Verneinung)

**If-Sätze Typ 3: Setze die Verben in der richtigen Form ein.**

1. If Mum **had left** the money on the table, Jake **would have done** the shopping. (leave / do)
2. If Jake **had won** the money, he **would have bought** a car. (win / buy)
3. If the teacher **had asked** her, she **would have answered**. (ask / answer)
4. If Mum **hadn't gone** out, she **wouldn't have invited** her friends. (go / **not** invite) (Kurzform der Verneinung)
