

**Conditional sentences / If clauses, type III****LÖSUNG**Der If-Satz Typ 3 bedeutet: Etwas war *völlig unmöglich*.

If- Satz <b>Past Perfect</b>	<b>would + have + Past Participle</b>	
If the cat had jumped,	it <b>would have caught</b> the mouse.	

**1. Setze die Verben für den Typ III in der richtigen Form ein.**

1. If he **had gone** to France, he would have learned/learnt French. (go)
2. If Ben **had told** scary stories, the children would have been frightened. (tell)
3. The dog **would have barked** if there had been anyone at the door. (bark)
4. If I had had nothing to do, I **would have come**.
5. He would have written an email if he **had heard** any news. (hear)

**2. Setze die Verben für Typ III in der richtigen Form ein.**

1. He **would have come** yesterday if he **had had** nothing to do. (come/have)
2. If you **had done** as I had said , you **would have won**. (do/win)
3. If I **had lost** my mobile, I **wouldn't have been** able to call you. (lose/**not** be) (Kurzform der Verneinung)
4. You **would have found** the book if you **had opened** the bag. (find/open)
5. It **would have broken** if you **hadn't caught** it. (break/**not** catch) (Kurzform)

**3. If-Sätze Typ 3: Setze die Verben für Typ III in der richtigen Form ein.**

1. If you **had enjoyed** the party, you **wouldn't have gone** home. (enjoy/not go) (Kurzform)
2. **Would you have told** him the truth if you **had had** to? (tell/have)
3. If Jake **had liked** the film, he **would have bought** the DVD. (like/buy)
4. If we **had gone** to the summer camp, we **would have stayed** in a cabin. (go/stay)
5. If I **hadn't told** him, he **would never have known**. (not tell/know) (Kurzform)
