4. Emma would have opened her own shop if she had had the money. Conditional, Typ 3
5. If the policeman had been quicker, he would have caught the thief. Conditional, Typ 3
6. If I were you, I would do a computer course. Conditional, Typ 2
7. If it was your birthday, I would buy you a present. Conditional, Typ 2
8. Emma will write a report if the teacher asks her to. Conditional, Typ 1
9. If you don't know the number, you won't be able to phone him. Conditional, Typ 1
10. If she had sent us a photo, we would have recognized her. Conditional, Typ 3

1. if Ben – have – a better computer / he – play – computer games (3)
If **Ben had had a better computer**, he **would have played computer games**.
2. If – he – fall – down the cliff / he – hurt – himself (2)
If **he fell down the cliff**, he **would hurt himself**.
3. If Lucy – sing – in the group / Jake – write – a new song (1)
If **Lucy sings in the group**, Jake **will write a new song**.
4. If the party – be – on Saturday / Emma – go – there (3)
If **the party had been on Saturday**, Emma **would have gone there**.
5. If the dress – be- red / Ben – give – Lucy – red flowers (1)
If **the dress is red**, Ben **will give Lucy red flowers**.
6. If the building – be – too high / I take – the lift (2)
If **the building was too high**, I **would take the lift**.
7. If the car – not start / we – be – late – for school (3)
If **the car hadn't started**, we **would have been late for school**.
