Mixed bag exercises: Welcher Typ ist es?

Entscheide, welcher If-Satz-Typ richtig ist und trage die Verben in die Lücken ein.

1. They didn't win the football game. They **would have won** if their best player **had been** there. (win/be)

2. She is very lazy. If I **was** her, I **would do** some homework. (be/do)

3. John went to Germany. He **wouldn't have gone** if Hans **hadn't invited** him. (not go/not invite)

4. John had an accident. If he **hadn't drunk** so much, he **wouldn't have had** the accident. (not drink/not have)

5. We are saving our money. We **will go** to France next year if we **save** enough money (go/save)

6. I did not feel ill any more, but if I **had felt** ill yesterday, I **would have gone** to the doctor's. (feel/go)

7. Maria took up English. If Maria **had known** English was so difficult, she **wouldn't have taken** it up. (know/not take)

8. The computer helped me to do my homework. If it **hadn't helped** me, I **wouldn't have done** it. (not help/not do)

9. My friend does not have a job. If I **were** her, I **would look** at the advertisements in the newspaper. (be/look)

10. She hopes she will have time to go to London. If she **goes** to London, she **will visit** the Tower. (go/visit)
