1. Trage die Verben für Type I, Typ II und Typ II richtig in die Lücken ein.



1. I don't suppose I **will** ever **win** a million euro. But if I won a million, I **would travel** around the world. (win/travel)

2. Yesterday it snowed. The pupils **wouldn't have stayed** at home if it **hadn't snowed**. (not stay/not snow)

3. She didn't do her homework. If she **had done** her homework, the teacher **wouldn't have been** so angry. (do/not be)

4. She feels ill. I **would go** to the doctor's if I **was** her. (go/be)

5. John will take the DLR. If he **takes** the DLR, he **will be** home more quickly. (take/be)

6. I hope the doctor will give her some tablets. If she **takes** the tablets then she **will feel** better. (take/feel)

7. She didn't go to the doctor's. He **would have sent** her to the hospital if she **had been** in great pain. (send/be)

8. Peter will light a campfire. If he **lights** a campfire, the children **will sing**. (light/sing)

9. Peter doesn't have enough money to buy a car. If he **had** enough, he **would buy** a Merceghini. (have/buy)

10. Jake didn't buy any flowers. If he **had bought** some flowers, Lucy **would have been** happy. (buy/be)
